Ethnic Studies at Grauer

In November 2022, we surveyed the Grauer faculty for integrated lessons on these groups:

African American

Chicano/a/x or Latino/a/x

Asian American

Native American

Jewish American

Muslim American

Pacific Islander

Other (if you teach about another group you want to mention)

The state legislature specified that African Americans, Native Americans, Latino/a/x Americans, and Asian Americans be included in the ethnic studies course, adding additional lessons that included Jewish Americans, Arab Americans, Armenian Americans and Pacific Islanders.

This is incredibly important work as we try to have our young people get a true picture of the nation's past, which we deeply believe will lead them to be more compassionate citizens and have a better understanding of our current society. Integrating different groups from American society into our courses also allows our students of color to connect directly with people that have a similar background - this representation is critically important.

FINDINGS:

- Students are getting a total of 32 weeks of Ethnic Studies from 7th-12th grade (***a semester is between 17 and 23 weeks)
 - o 22 weeks in High School Core Classes
 - o 10 weeks in Middle School Core Classes
- The most covered Ethnic Group is African Americans
- US History classes and World Religions cover the highest number of weeks of Ethnic Studies
